

# Friends' School Report Grades Sept 2007

## Attainment

- Student attainment is assessed on a 4 point scale A-D. The grades do not relate to national curriculum criteria and should be subject specific.
- Attainment levels Yr 7-9 are defined as:
  - A Achieving a very high standard
  - B Achieving a high standard
  - C Working at the standard expected.
  - D Working towards the standard expected
- Grades A-C are acceptable grades.
- Achievement grades beyond Yr 9 should reflect public exam grading systems.

## Personal Performance

Student personal performance/effort should be reported on in four areas on a numeric scale as follows:

### Attitude to work

- 1 Committed to and conscientious in work
- 2 Usually works well and tries hard
- 3 More consistent effort required
- 4 Seldom meets expectations

### Participation

- 1 Frequently makes perceptive contributions
- 2 Makes regular and positive contributions
- 3 Occasionally makes positive contributions
- 4 Rarely contributes

### Organisation

- 1 Well organised, fully equipped and able to meet deadlines
- 2 Well prepared, equipped and usually meets deadlines
- 3 Sometimes forgets equipment and fails to meet deadlines
- 4 Often without necessary items and regularly fails to meet deadlines

### Quality of Homework

- 1 Produces homework of a high standard
- 2 Usually produces homework of a good standard
- 3 Homework is of an acceptable standard
- 4 Homework is of poor quality
